

# DRESS CODE

It is important for students to dress appropriately for dance class. Wearing the correct leotard and tights allows the teacher to see their lines and technique. Dance shoes are very important for a dancer's safety and education. Please buy shoes that fit properly and are not too big, as this can cause injury. It is important for all dancers to wear their hair pulled into a ponytail or bun. For short hair that does not reach the shoulders, secure hair with a headband or barrettes to keep hair out of the face.

#### Toddler and Preschool Classes (Ages 2 1/2 yrs to 5)

- Solid-color tights
- Any color leotard or ballet dress
- Tap & Ballet shoes
- Hair in a ponytail or bun
- No costumes

#### All Ballet Classes Levels 8+, 9+, 10+, 13+

- Pink Tights
- Black leotard
- Dance skirt or dance shorts
- Pink ballet shoes
- Hair in a proper bun and bangs pinned

### Ballet, Tap/Jazz Classes 6-8 Level 1 & 2,

- Solid-color tights
- Any color leotard with skirt or dance shorts
- Tap, Jazz, or Ballet shoes
- Hair in a ponytail or bun

### Tap, Jazz, Contemporary & Team Classes Levels 8+, 9+, 10+, 13+

- Tan or Pink Tights
- Black leotard
- Dance shorts, skirt or leggings
- Appropriate dance shoes
- Hair in a proper bun and bangs pinned

## Triple Threat & Tiny Praise

- Solid-color tights
- Any color leotard with skirt, shorts or leggings
- Jazz shoes
- Hair in a pony tail or bun
- Absolutely no bare legs, bra tops where the stomach is exposes or street clothes
- Do not wear old costumes or big skirts; they are distracting for young dancers
- <u>All jewelry</u>, necklaces, bracelets and rings <u>must be removed</u> before class
